

Focus Awards Level 3 Award in Assessing Vocationally Related Achievement (RQF)

Overview

The Level 3 Award in Assessing Vocationally Related Achievement, is considered to be an entry qualification for people looking to assess learners on accredited courses. Most training centres would expect that you at least have this assessor qualification before you start assessing in the FE and HE sectors. You are not required to have any prior qualification or experience to start this course, just a passion to teach or train, and access to learners to assess to meet the practical requirements of the course. This NVQ assessor course will assist you regardless of your subject expertise, whether you teach music or coach people. The course is accredited by UK OFQUAL and is delivered 100% online with tutor support.

Duration and Delivery

This course is designed to be completed online at the pace that suits you the best. By taking this level 3 assessor course it can take as little as 3 days (fast track) or up to 2 months to become an assessor of vocationally related achievement. The level 3 assessor qualification is delivered through our Virtual Learning Environment. Our online tutor support is there to facilitate you in achieving your success.

Assessment & Verification

All units within this assessor qualification are internally verified by our qualified assessors and externally verified by the awarding organisation. The assessment takes the form of written assignments and demonstration of assessment skills through video recording, detailed guidance for which will be provided by the tutor.

Eligibility Criteria

Learners should be aged 19 or over to undertake the qualification and have access to at least two learners on accredited courses.

Progression

Successful completion of this assessor course enables learners to proceed to the full **Level 3 Certificate in Assessing Vocational Achievement** (for which you could gain RPL for 2/3 units and thus only do 1 unit for completion), the **Level 4 Certificate in Leading the IQA of Assessment Processes and Practice** and the **Level 4 Certificate in Education and Training**. This level 3 assessor course will also help you enhance your career profile and become an apprenticeship assessor (although some centres may request that you have the full CAVA qualification).
