You will also need access to learners to teach in order to meet the practical requirements of this course. The Level 4 Certificate in Education and Training or CTLTS is accredited by UK Ofqual and is delivered 100% online. This course will assist you regardless of your subject expertise to upgrade your teaching qualification - whether you teach music or coach people.

Intended Audience

With this teacher training qualification, you can teach in diverse fields such as the Culinary Arts, Engineering, Music Teaching, Performing Arts, Driving Instruction, Hospitality & Catering, NHS training, Personal Services, Teacher's Training, Freelance Teaching and Training, and many more industries.

Duration and Delivery

Assessment & Verification

- Have a satisfactory level of Literacy and Numeracy skills
- Must not have a criminal background which prevents you from becoming a teacher
